

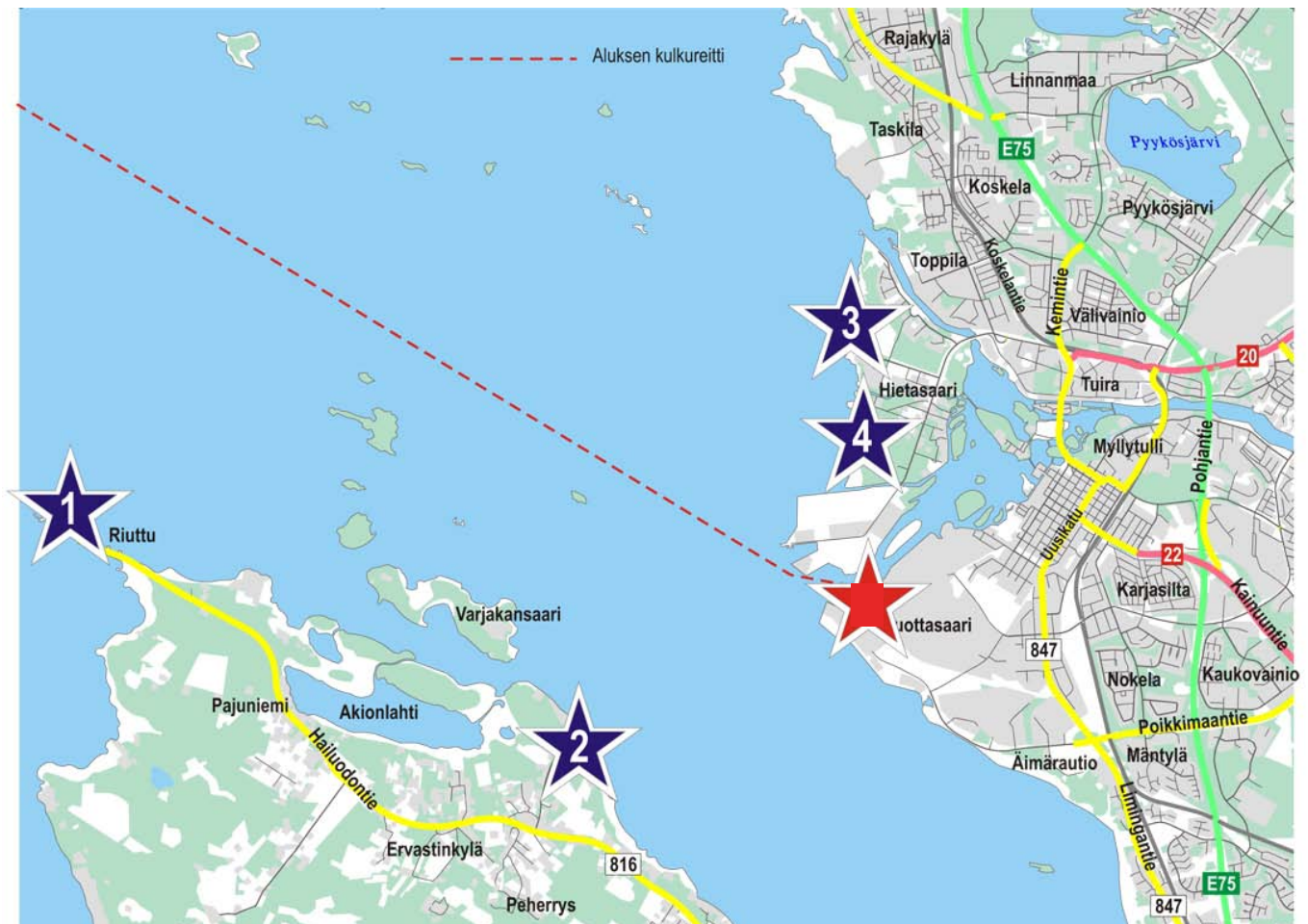
THE SAILING SHIP "SEDOV" IN OULU

June 18–20, 2010
Oritkari harbour, Oulu

Arrival

The world's largest sailing ship "SEDOV" will arrive in Oulu, Oritkari harbour on June 18 approx. at 12:00. You can watch the ship's arrival, for instance, in Nallikari, onshore in Hietasaari, in Oulunsalo Riutunkari or in Varjakka. The best viewing points are marked on the map.

Berthing is not allowed in the Oulu harbour, and you are not allowed to come ashore in the harbour area at any point.



Viewing points

1. Riutunkari
2. Varjakka
3. Nallikari
4. Hietasaari

You can watch the ship's arrival from the north side of Hailuoto, as well.

OULU10 Service Point, Torikatu 10, Oulu

Sales period June 1-20, 2010

The Service Point is open Mon-Thu 8–17 and Fri 8-16. Over the weekend, June 19–20, open 8–16. (only ticket sales, no other services)

We hope that all groups will buy their tickets in advance at the Oulu10 Service Point.

Äimärautio trotting track, Oulu

Sales period June 19-20, 2010

The ticket sales points are open 8-16. There are 6 ticket sales points: one for cash sales and the others for card payment.

Please note that the tickets are not sold on the bus.

The Oulu harbour is a closed area, so you can only visit the sailing ship by taking the chartered bus. You cannot access the harbour area by car or on foot. The purpose of this arrangement is to guarantee the visitors' safety.



Bus transport

Buses leave from two stops:

from the Äimärautio trotting track forecourt and from the Oulu city centre, Kaarlenväylä, next to the Ahtisaari square. The buses are marked with a sign "SEDOV".

Buses: June 19–20, 8:30–16:30 approx. every 15 minutes

Route 1:

Kaarlenväylä next to the Ahtisaari square – Oritkari harbour – Kaarlenväylä

The last bus from the ship to Kaarlenväylä leaves at 17.00.



Route 2:

Äimärautio trotting track forecourt – Oritkari harbour – Äimärautio

The last bus from the ship to Äimärautio leaves at 17.00.



In Äimärautio there is a parking area for approx. 1,300 cars during the event. You can park either near the trotting track or in the area between Wetteri and the trotting track. There is traffic control in the area.

Parking is free.

General arrangements

You can buy ice cream, coffee, refreshments, sausages and other snacks in the harbour area. You can pay with cash or card.
